# ALL DANCING EVENTS WILL BE HELD UNDER THE RULES OF THE ROYAL SCOTTISH OFFICIAL BOARD OF HIGHLAND DANCING (RSOBHD).

## ALL EVENTS WILL BE HELD IN THE NAN DALEY PAVILION (The Hangar Building).

- 1. Any protest must be submitted in writing to the Chairperson of the Highland Dance Committee, properly signed and accompanied by a fee of \$20, and it must be made immediately following the posting of the results. If the protest is sustained, the fee will be returned.
- 2. Communication with a judge, piper or scrutineer, with respect to a competitor, will result in disqualification of that competitor.
- 3. The Organizer reserves the right to change any event or time schedule and to split or combine dance groups based on the number of entries within the scope of RSOBHD rules. Age groups for the Pacific Coast Open Championship may be changed at the discretion of the Organizer after entries have been received.
- 4. Dancers must be in costume to receive awards. If there are three dancers or fewer in any event, medals will be awarded at judges' discretion.
- 5. Last to enter, first to dance. Dancers must be ready and appear when called or forfeit the chance to dance in that event.
- All dancers must be registered with SDUSA or another registration body in order to dance. YOU MUST PRESENT YOUR 2023 DANCER REGISTRATION CARD TO COMPETE! No digital or paper copy of card will be accepted.
- 7. All dance competitors, teachers, and parents are expected to comply with the ScotDance USA Code of Ethics.
- 8. Competitor numbers will be given out during event check in.
- WEST REGIONAL (CLOSED) CHAMPIONSHIP and PACIFIC COAST OPEN CHAMPIONSHIP 2023 set steps as
  prescribed by the RSOBHD must be danced.
- 10. WEST REGIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP WINNERS The top three place finishers in each age group in the Saturday championship are expected to represent the West Region at the United States Inter-Regional Championship in Portland, OR on July 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2023. All USIR representatives in each age group are required to participate in the USS' Saturday Closing Ceremonies. Champions MAY be asked to dance the Highland Laddie with the pipebands.
- 11. CITY OF EDINBURGH SHIELD To qualify for the City of Edinburgh Shield, a dancer must win a 1<sup>st</sup> prize in the Fling, Sword or Seann Triubhas in the 7 & U10, 10 & U12, 12 & U14, and 14 & U16 sections in the West Regional Closed Championship. The dance-off will be danced immediately after the Championship. Total aggregate points of the judges will determine the winner. The dance is listed on the first page of the entry. No set steps are required for the dance-off.
- 12. Competitors may only compete in events in which their respective birth date applies. Saturday Regional Championship, age as of July 15<sup>th</sup>, 2023. In all other events, age as of May 27th, 2023.
- 13. CHOREOGRAPHY COMPETITIONS RSOBHD Choreography rules will be followed. No separate entry fee is required any dancer (Pre-Premier or Premier) who enters another competitive event during the weekend is eligible to compete. Please notify Organizer of intent to compete on the entry form. Dancers may enter both the Solo and Duet competitions. Dancers may enter AT MOST one Solo event and as part of one Duet team. Both dancers in the Duet team must be entered in another competitive event during the weekend. Duet teams pairing a Premier dancer and a Pre-Premier dancer will be entered in the Premier Duet group. Duet teams pairing a dancer older than 16 years with a dancer under 16 years will be entered in the 16 years and over section. Music must be pre-recorded and electronically submitted to Megan Ashworth (at <a href="megan.ashworth1@gmail.com">megan.ashworth1@gmail.com</a>) by May 15th. Music may include vocals or percussion, but must be predominantly Scottish or Celtic in style. SOLO EVENTS: Maximum time length of 2 minutes. DUET EVENTS: Maximum time length of 2 minutes.
- 14. AGGREGATE TROPHIES PREMIER EVENTS: An aggregate trophy will be presented in the Saturday Nationals competition. An aggregate trophy will be awarded for any Championship age group with fewer than 6 competitors. PRE-PREMIER EVENTS (Beginner, Novice, and Intermediate): One aggregate trophy will be presented in each Pre-Premier age group on Saturday. One aggregate trophy will be presented in each Pre-Premier age group on Sunday. CHOREOGRAPHY EVENTS: Only cash awards will be presented in each group for Solos and for Duet teams.
- 15. PRIZE MONEY PREMIER EVENTS: Cash prizes for dancers in each 16 & over age groups in the Pacific Coast Open Championship and Premier Nationals 1<sup>st</sup>-\$30, 2<sup>nd</sup>-\$25, 3<sup>rd</sup>-\$20, 4<sup>th</sup>-\$15, 5<sup>th</sup>-\$10, 6<sup>th</sup>-\$5. Number of cash prizes awarded in each category will be 2 fewer than the number of competitors, up to a maximum of 6 prizes. CHOREOGRAPHY EVENTS: PREMIER SOLOS 1<sup>st</sup>-\$100, 2<sup>nd</sup>-\$75, 3<sup>rd</sup>-\$50 provided there are 6 or more competitors in the group; 1<sup>st</sup>-\$50, 2<sup>nd</sup>-\$30, 3<sup>rd</sup>-\$20 if there are fewer than 6 competitors. PREMIER DUETS 1<sup>st</sup>-\$200, 2<sup>nd</sup>-\$150, 3<sup>rd</sup>-\$100 provided there are 6 or more competitors in the group; 1<sup>st</sup>-\$100, 2<sup>nd</sup>-\$60, 3<sup>rd</sup>-\$40 if there are fewer than 6 competitors. PRE-PREMIER SOLOS 1<sup>st</sup>-\$40, 2<sup>nd</sup>-\$30, 3<sup>rd</sup>-\$20 provided there are 6 or more competitors in the group; 1<sup>st</sup>-\$30, 2<sup>nd</sup>-\$20, 3<sup>rd</sup>-\$10 if there are fewer than 6 competitors. PRE-PREMIER DUETS 1<sup>st</sup>-\$80, 2<sup>nd</sup>-\$60, 3<sup>rd</sup>-\$40 provided there are 6 or more competitors in the group; 1<sup>st</sup>-\$60, 2<sup>nd</sup>-\$40, 3<sup>rd</sup>-\$20 if there are fewer than 6 competitors.
