Dance competitors will need to check in and pick up packets at the main entrance gate. Parents and guests will need to purchase entrance tickets before entering the festival.

Competition Rules

- Competition will be governed by RSOBHD and ScotDance USA rules.
- All dancers must have a valid SDUSA or Scotdance registration number to enter. A valid 2023 card is required to receive awards. Dancers will NOT be able to complete if a card is not present at registration.
- Photographs and videos can only be taken of your dancer unless permission is granted by a parent/guardian.
- Change in classification must be received by July 11, 2023.
- This is a non-refundable entry.
- Organizers reserve the right to cancel, split or combine, add events or makes changes within the RSOBHD rules. Competitors will dance in reverse order of entry.
- All competitors are expected to comply with SDUSA Code of Ethics.
- Any dancer causing delay will forfeit entry in any event. Any attempt to approach a judge or piper on behalf of a competitor may result in disqualification.
- Dancers must be in competition dress to accept all awards.
- Decisions of the judge are final. Protests must be made in writing and submitted to the Executive Secretary with a fee of \$5.00 before the end of the competition. Fee will be returned if protest is sustained.
- All dances count toward aggregate trophies each day and is awarded to the dancer in their class and age category with the highest points.
- Pre-Premier dancers that place both Saturday and Sunday will only receive 1 stamp over the course of the weekend.
- Premier Under 12 and Pre-Premier dancers will receive medals for 1st through 6th places. Premier classes 12 and older will receive cash awards and medals. Aggregate trophies are based on the number of dancers and age groups. Distribution of prize money in Premier 12 and older categories will be determined on breakdown of age groups.
- Premier age groups will be based on total number of registrations.
- Grand Canyon Trophy choreography is open to Premier dancers in both solo and duet.
- Special choreography music must be to "This is your Fight Song" by either Rachel Platten' or the Piano Guys. Both versions will be available by the competition committee.
- Novice dancer of the day "Flora's Fancy" is open to Arizona Novice dancers competing to Flora MacDonald's Fancy. Trophy sponsored by Diana Spellman in honor of the Girl Scouts.
- Most Promising Dancer will be awarded in the Beginner, Novice, and Intermediate categories. This cash award is sponsored by the Arizona Highland Dancing Association (AZHDA) and will be judges choice.
- Competitor numbers will be issued at registration.
