Special Dance Events

16 Years and Over Cash Awards

- The following cash awards will be given in lieu of medals for Premier categories ages 16 and over:
 - 1st \$40, 2nd \$30, 3rd \$20, 4th \$15, 5th \$10, 6th \$5

Margo Naismith Memorial Sword Dance

- To qualify, dancers must place 1st, 2nd, or 3rd in the Sword Dance in their respective Premier age group and be under 16 years old.
- Qualifiers will dance a **Sword (2&1)**.

House of Scotland Sword Dance

- To qualify, dancers must place 1st, 2nd, or 3rd in the Sword Dance in their respective Premier age group and be 16 years or older.
- Qualifiers will dance a **Sword (2&1)**.

The Sailors' Hornpipe Award

- To qualify, dancers must place 1st or 2nd in the Sailors' Hornpipe in their respective Premier age group.
- Qualifiers will dance a **Hornpipe (4)**.

Special Pre-Premier Scholarships

- A "Judge's Honorable Mention" scholarship will be awarded to one Beginner, one Novice, and one Intermediate. (Sponsors: Macleod Pacific Region)

Dancing Rules

1. The competition is governed by RSOBHD and ScotDance USA rules.
2. All dance competitors and teachers are expected to comply with the RSOBHD Code of Ethics & SDUSA Code of Ethics.
3. All dancers must be registered with ScotDance USA, or another registration body in order to dance. Registration Number MUST be on Entry Form and dance card must be produced on the day of the event in order to compete.
4. Age groups and start time will be determined after entries are received.
5. Organizer reserves the right to split or combine classes the day of the competition.
6. Dancers who are last to enter will be first to dance, and when applicable the dancer will fill in for a reel.
7. Communication by a dancer or parent of a dancer with the judge is not allowed.
8. Pre-Premier category changes must be made by June 15, 2024.
9. Dancers not on hand when their class is called will forfeit entry on that event.
10. All winners must be in costume to accept awards.
11. Entry fee includes dancer admission to the games.
12. Competitor numbers will be distributed at the event during registration.
13. Entries must be SUBMITTED by June 1, 2024. Late entries will be accepted with DOUBLE FEES.
14. Entry fees are as follows: Primary- \$35, Beginner- \$40, Novice- \$40, Intermediate- \$40, Premier- \$45
15. An additional \$5 fee per dancer goes to SDUSA West.
16. Entry fees are non-refundable.
17. 3 Month Rule: Judges who conduct teaching or coaching classes, seminars or any other forms of tuition (eg. by video conferencing), may not adjudicate any competitor who has attended any of these classes, for a period of three months after the last class, workshop, or any other form of tuition that competitor has attended.
18. Judge's decision is final. Any protest must be in writing, signed, and handed to the Dance Director by the end of the competition, accompanied by a fee of \$30.00 that would be refundable if the protest is sustained.
